

## Heroes Haven Jerome Rogers Memorial Scholarship

Heroes Haven has set aside scholarship funds for Heroes Haven alumni and their immediate family members. Awards will be issued annually in the amount of \$500-1000. The number and amount of grants will depend on the success of fundraising activities and number of applicants.

Applications will be accepted annually (Jan-May) and must be completed in its entirety. Applications will be weighed on basis of financial need, academic achievement, and community involvement. Recipients will be chosen and notified by the end of June.

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, applicant must be an alumni, alumni spouse, or alumni child(ren) of the Heroes Haven program and enrolled in a college or university for the upcoming Fall semester.
